WHEREAS: The Reverend Edward C. Ramacher, a Roman Catholic Priest, has served the good people of the diocese of St. Cloud, of the State of Minnesota, and many others throughout the United States, with dignity, fervor, and helpfulness for more than 42 years; and

WHEREAS: This work and effort performed by Father Ramacher, whether religious, community, educational or civic was always performed in a thoroughly outstanding and professional manner; and

WHEREAS: His tasks as a chairman of the Rural and Family Life Bureaus and in the Country Beautiful campaigns were truly outstanding; and
