WHEREAS: His speech team consistently brought national recognition to the college; and


WHEREAS: In his battle with cancer he set a standard for courage that few if any of us will ever be asked to achieve;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 31 to be

In Minnesota.


