



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Israel, like the United States, is a country founded and developed by immigrants of many cultural and ethnic backgrounds; and

WHEREAS: The Israeli government, like that of the United States, is guided by the principles of democracy and equality; and

WHEREAS: Harry S. Truman first granted recognition of Israel's statehood; and

WHEREAS: The citizens of Minnesota recognize the need for understanding and cooperation between the Jewish and Christian communities in seeking peace for all mankind;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 27 to be

H O N O R I S R A E L D A Y

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eleventh day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-seven, and of the State the one hundred twenty-ninth.
