WHEREAS: Hunger has reached epidemic proportions in our world; and

WHEREAS: The National Student Campaign Against Hunger is a student-run organization to fight hunger; and

WHEREAS: Students in Minnesota's Colleges in the Twin Cities, Duluth, and Winona, along with students around the country, are joining forces to fight hunger and clean up their cities; and

WHEREAS: This Hunger Cleanup will provide a sense of community and self-help which is needed in our area while meeting the needs of those less fortunate; and

WHEREAS: On Saturday, April 11, 1987, students from this area will be working at local community service projects while raising money for local and worldwide hunger coalitions;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 11, 1987, to be
