- WHEREAS: The significant and extensive contributions made by the officers and members of the International Brotherhood of Painters and Allied Trades have been vital to the Labor Movements of the United States and Canada; and
- WHEREAS: The work performed by the members of this Union over the past 100 years has served to protect and decorate North America; and
- WHEREAS: The Brotherhood of Painters was formed to foster and adopt ways and means for the continuous improvement of the working and living standards of their members and families; and
- WHEREAS: The Painters Union has influenced public opinion by peaceful and legal means; and
- WHEREAS: This Labor organization has promoted, encouraged and brought into existence satisfactory contractual relationships with employers in the industries from which the members of their affiliates are drawn; and
- WHEREAS: Special recognition is due the International Brotherhood of Painters and Allied Trades in celebration of the 100th anniversary of the founding of this prominent Labor organization;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the third Tuesday in June to be

INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF PAINTERS AND ALLIED TRADES DAY


in Minnesota.
