WHEREAS: Charles Lindbergh's fascination with aviation and technology and love of nature began during his boyhood years in Little Falls, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: 1987 marks the 60th anniversary of this Minnesota and world hero's solo, nonstop crossing of the Atlantic Ocean from New York to Paris; and

WHEREAS: The Charles A. Lindbergh Fund, headquartered in Minnesota, is dedicated to preserving the heritage of Charles Lindbergh and extending his philosophy of the need to balance technological advancement and environmental preservation; and

WHEREAS: The Lindbergh Fund will conduct numerous programs in Minnesota during the May 20-21 flight anniversary period and throughout the year to promote aviation and the Lindbergh legacy; and

WHEREAS: These programs will be carried out at the State Capitol, in Little Falls, and at various airports throughout the state; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 17, 1987, to be

LINDBERGH 60th ANNIVERSARY WEEK

in Minnesota.
