- WHEREAS: Merle Evans is known internationally as "America's Toscanini of the Big Top" because of his 50 years of never having missed a performance as director of Ringling Bros. Barnum and Bailey Combined Shows Circus Band from 1919 to 1969; and
- WHEREAS: The editor of "Etude" music magazine referred to him as "Will Rogers with a horn;" and
- WHEREAS: Merle is coming to the great State of Minnesota for the third time since 1974 to direct the Chatfield Brass Band of Chatfield, Minnesota, on Thursday, April 23, at the Apache Mall in Rochester, Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: More than 159,000,000 children of all ages have been overwhelmed and overjoyed by this thrilling, exciting, and fast-moving circus band music; and
- WHEREAS: Merle Evans has recognized the historical significance of preserving America's musical heritage by serving on the international board of advisors to the Chatfield Brass Band Free Music Lending Library located at Chatfield, Minnesota--the only free music lending library in the world today; and
- WHEREAS: Merle is a constant inspiration to musicians of all ages because of his willingness to share his musical talents by continuing to perform guest performances all over this nation; and
- WHEREAS: Merle will be conducting the first concert of the 9th annual conference of the Association of Concert Bands in Minnesota, the first time this organization has ever met in Minnesota;
