## Proclamation

WHEREAS: Miles M. Miles Johnson will mark his forty-third year at St. Olaf College as both music director and conductor of the nationally-acclaimed St. Olaf College Band; and

WHEREAS: Miles Johnson has represented Minnesota nationally and abroad as a sought-after guest conductor and clinician, directing all-state bands, university bands, at music camps and conducting seminars, resulting in his selection as one of ten outstanding American music educators; and

WHEREAS: Miles Johnson has provided an opportunity for post-college instrumentalists to continue performing arts, by founding and conducting the Minneapolis Symphonic Winds, a Twin Cities-based adult community band; and

WHEREAS: Miles Johnson has served as teacher and mentor to dozens of musicians who have gone on to make contributions in the field of music as educators and professional musicians in their own right; and

WHEREAS: In May, Miles Johnson will lead the St. Olaf Band on its third tour of Norway and other tour of Europe since assuming the position of Director of Music at St. Olaf College in 1957;
