WHEREAS: Northern Minnesota's Iron Range was once among the most important industrial areas in

the country, providing a substantial portion of the nation's iron ore; and

WHEREAS: The Hill Annex Vine in Calumut, Minnesota, remains open to educate the public about

the way of life in these mining towns; and

WHEREAS: The people who worked in the mines--many of whom were European immigrants--helped form

the basis of the character of the people in the great State of Minnesota; and

celebrating Miner's Day on the third Sunday of July;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 19 to
