



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Counties of Clearwater, Hubbard, Beltrami, Cass, Itasca, Aitkin, Crow Wing and Morrison joined together to form the Mississippi Headwaters Board; and

WHEREAS: The Mississippi Headwaters Board has successfully prepared and implemented a comprehensive program for protection of the upper 400 miles of the Mississippi River; and

WHEREAS: The work of the MHB, its advisory committee and the counties themselves has been widely recognized as having created a national model for cooperative local river management; and

WHEREAS: The efforts of the counties and the MHB exemplify the very best in creative leadership, which has reflected well upon the Board, the State of Minnesota and all associated with this program; and

WHEREAS: Such leadership and innovation are the essential qualities which help make Minnesota a successful state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 13, 1987, to be

in Minnesota.
