



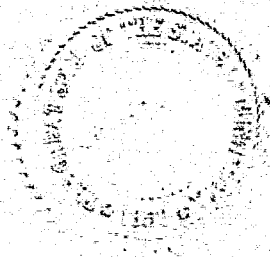
Proclamation

- WHEREAS: There is now widespread agreement that smoking is a health hazard, not only to those who smoke, but to those who endure smoking by others; and
- WHEREAS: Patrick Reynolds is an active participant in efforts to promote a smoke-free lifestyle for all Americans; and
- WHEREAS: He has come to Minnesota at the request of the Minnesota Coalition for a Smoke-Free Society 2000, an organization that represents 35 member groups and 250,000 Minnesotans, all supporting the idea of a smoke-free state and a smoke-free nation; and
- WHEREAS: The dedication of leaders such as Patrick Reynolds is important in publicizing these efforts to bring better health to all citizens; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota, a leader in the effort to bring about a smoke-free society, is especially grateful of efforts by Patrick Reynolds to help lead this battle;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 13, 1987, to be

in Minnesota, in commemoration of his mission to educate, inspire and lead this nation in the direction of better health.
