




Proclamation


- WHEREAS: Alcohol-related automobile crashes are the primary cause of death among teenagers; and
- WHEREAS: 44 percent of all fatal night accidents involving substance abuse are caused by drivers between the ages of 16 and 24; and
- WHEREAS: Drunk Driving causes an immeasurable toll in human suffering and loss; and
- WHEREAS: Students Against Driving Drunk has been organized to save lives by educating students and the public about the problem of drinking and driving; and
- WHEREAS: Members of SADD pledge not to drink and drive, not to be a passenger in a car with a drunk driver, and to encourage fellow students to avoid mixing alcohol and automobiles; and
- WHEREAS: A disproportionate number of accidents involving youth occur in connection with high school prom and graduation activities; and
- WHEREAS: SADD chapters throughout the state will be working to prevent tragic alcohol-related accidents during the months of May and June; and
- WHEREAS: Many lives have been saved through programs that have been instituted for prom and graduation time; and
- WHEREAS: SADD urges young people to be particularly aware of the dangers of drunk driving during the months of May and June and the festivities associated with prom and graduation;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the months of May and June to be

STUDENTS AGAINST DRUNK DRIVING MONTHS

in Minnesota.


