This will confirm receipt of your letter dated June 12.

I am the Honorary Consul of Costa Rica to Minnesota having been appointed by the then President of the Republic of Costa Rica, Luis Alberto Monge in September, 1983.

If your records show any person other than me as Consul, I'd appreciate knowing about it and the person's name and address and phone number.

As to your request regarding Minnesota Statutes 524.3 403(a), covering receipt of notice of probate for decedents born in Costa Rica, may I suggest the following;

- if I, as Honorary Consul, can be of help or service in any way to you, the State of Minnesota, the family, etc., do not hesitate to call or write;
- to the best of my knowledge, since my appointment as Honorary Consul, neither I nor my office has received any such notification;
