
WHEREAS: These young men and their families need the support of their friends and neighbors in this most difficult of times;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 20 to be

HANSON - WADENA - WILSON BURN VICTIM FUND DAY


in Minnesota.
