NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 24 to be

MINNESOTA MUSIC VIDEO DAY

in Minnesota in recognition of achievement and dedication to excellence in music video production and performing arts by Minnesotans.
