WHEREAS: Ms. Wheelchair America is chosen to serve one year as a goodwill ambassarior for disabled

people of the state in seeking a full, productive and rewarding life; and

WHEREAS: Ms. Wheelchair America also serves as a role model for vounger and newly disabled

individuals;

YOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 19 through August 23 to be

MS. WHEELCHAIR AMERICA DAYS

in Minnesota.
