WHEREAS: The Children's Bureau, established in 1912, works with state and local agencies to develop programs to assist families; and

WHEREAS: The Bureau has, in part, addressed such issues as child labor, maternal and child health, and juvenile delinquency; and

WHEREAS: In partnership with state government, the Bureau seeks to strengthen troubled families and help them stay together, find permanent homes for foster care children, help families deal with problems of child abuse and neglect, and improve social services to all children; and

WHEREAS: For 75 years, the Children's Bureau has been a focal point for national concern about children and families;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 7 to be

in Minnesota.
