



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Common childhood diseases such as measles, polio, whooping cough and diarrhea-related diseases are responsible for the deaths of 40,000 children each day in developing countries -- needless deaths that can be prevented with simple, intensive medical techniques; and

WHEREAS: The Minneapolis - Saint Paul Campaign for Child Survival Action Group, a collaborative effort of many organizations and individuals, is part of a worldwide movement to save children's lives in developing countries; and

WHEREAS: Established to organize and mobilize a wide range of human and material resources to focus public education, awareness and action on global child survival and to draw attention to related health issues of Minnesota's children, the Campaign for Child Survival aspires to raise public awareness and the political will to make child health and survival a priority;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October to be

CHILD SURVIVAL MONTH

in Minnesota.
