WHEREAS: The high technology/data processing industry is deeply involved in furthering the development of the state of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: High technology/data processing companies contribute significantly to the economy of, and are a major employer for, the state of Minnesota and its citizens; and

WHEREAS: High technology/data processing education is an area of major commitment for these companies and for schools, colleges and universities in the state of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Three professional organizations, the Data Processing Management Association, Association of Computing Machinery and Association of Systems Management, promote the interests of the industry and the state of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The objectives of these organizations and the high technology/data processing industry will be achieved by the upcoming 25th annual Northwest Computer Show and the 10th annual Minnesota Joint Computer Conference; and

WHEREAS: These two events held jointly will bring together approximately 100 major Minnesota companies, 150 exhibits and 6,000 professional data processing and corporate management personnel;
