WHEREAS: He has titillated the beautiful women of the world with his charming introductions; and


WHEREAS: He has accomplished these astounding feats at age 57, while looking 27, and acting 17;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, July 18, 1987, to be

DAN J. BRUTGER DAY


in Minnesota.
