WHEREAS: Ira Flatow has broadened people's understanding and appreciation of science; and


WHEREAS: Ira Flatow has helped guide "Newton's Apple" into a position of national prominence;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 9 to be

in Minnesota.


