WHEREAS: In 1866 Congress authorized the use of the metric system of measurement in the United

States; and

WHEREAS: The Metric Conversion Act of 1975 established a national colley promoting the

increased use of the metric system (the International System of Units) in this nation;

and

WHEREAS: The metric system is being used extensively by U.S. manufacturing firms and being

taught at all levels of education; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota has extensive contacts and trade with many other nations, all

of which use the international metric system; and

WHEREAS: The Vational Council on State Metrication, the U.S. Vetric Association, the Vational

Council of Teachers of Mathematics, and other worthy organizations have designated the

week containing the tenth day of the tenth month as "National Metric Neek;"
