WHEREAS: Use of the 911 emergency telephone network has been shown to be an effective strategy for enhancing the effectiveness of emergency medicine, law enforcement, public safety and other emergency services; and

WHEREAS: The 911 network can play a vital role in saving lives, promoting better health and providing for the safety of citizens throughout our state; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota has already established itself as a national leader in implementing the 911 strategy, through successful efforts to provide access to the 911 network for citizens throughout the state; and

WHEREAS: Widespread public awareness of the 911 emergency telephone number is essential if we are to make the most effective use of this very valuable tool for saving lives and promoting the well-being of our people; and

WHEREAS: The day of September 11, 1987, has been set aside nationally for the purpose of enhancing public awareness of the 911 network and encouraging its use;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 11 to be
