



## Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The Games of the XV Olympiad will take place in Calgary, Alberta, February 13-28, 1988; and the Games of the XXIV Olympiad will take place in Seoul, South Korea, September 17-October 2, 1988; and
- WHEREAS: Minneapolis/St. Paul has been selected as the host site for the U.S. Olympic Festival, sponsored by the United States Olympic Committee, to be held in July in 1990; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota is home to many former as well as future Olympic champions and is dedicated to the development of future Olympians; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesotans should rally to build the state's financial and athletic resources in support of the 1988 Olympic team; and
- WHEREAS: We applaud the varied efforts of Minnesota's corporate sponsors and individuals who are committed to supporting the Olympic Games; and
- WHEREAS: We recognize the U.S. Olympic Festival and its importance to Minnesotans training for future Olympic Games; and
- WHEREAS: We believe that, in the words of the Olympic Creed, "The most important thing in the Olympic Games is not to win, but to take part;"
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 12 through July 18 to be

in Minnesota.
