WHEREAS: Twenty Minnesota teachers are going to the Soviet Union on June 20, 1987, under the auspices of the Minnesota-Soviet Seminar; and

WHEREAS: Each will return and develop curriculum to be used in schools throughout the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The State Department of Education affirms the importance of global education in the Minnesota schools; and

WHEREAS: Business, community and education leaders throughout the state support teaching and learning about the Soviet Union in the schools and in the community; and

WHEREAS: Educators and Minnesota citizens are gathering today to explore ways to enhance the teaching and learning about the Soviet Union and Soviet-American relations;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim participants in the

1987 MINNESOTA-SOVIET SEMINAR

to be ambassadors to the Soviet Union representing Minnesota citizens who support global education in the Minnesota schools.
