

Proclamation

Owen J. Gromme was born over 91 years ago in Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, on July 6, 1896; and WHEREAS:

WHEREAS:

Mr. Gromme did not become an artist by profession until his retirement at age 70 from the Wilwaukee Public Museum where he was curator of birds and mammals; and

Mr. Gromme has been nationally recognized in his field since the 1940's when he began painting a series of 323 American birds for his book, <u>Birds of Wisconsin</u>; and WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: In 1945 he was selected to design the Federal Duck Stamp; and

WHEREAS:

Owen Gromme is the first recipient of the Leigh Yawkey Woodson Art Museum Master Wildlife Artist award, and in 1978 was selected as the Ducks Unlimited Artist of the Year, and in 1983 was named Wildlife Artist of the Year by the National Wildlife

Art Collectors Society; and

WHEREAS: Over 100 full-cover reproductions of his work are included in his latest book, The

World of Owen Gromme; and

When the names of wildlife masters--Fuertes, Wilson, Audubon--echo in the halls of art history, we will also proudly hear the name of Owen Gromme; WHEREAS:
