

ORDINANCE

The Village Council of the Village of Hamburg in the State of Minnesota do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That there has been duly presented to this Village Council a petition signed by a majority of the owners of land in Truwe's Addition, said Addition being a duly and regularly platted subdivision containing less than 200 acres and abutting on this Village of Hamburg, petitioning this Council to have said Truwe's Addition included within the Village of Hamburg and that this Council extend the village boundaries of this village so as to include said Truwe's Addition within the same.

Section 2. That this Council deems it expedient and to the best interests of the owners of land in said Truwe's Addition and to the inhabitants of said Village of Hamburg that the boundaries of said village be extended so as to include said Truwe's Addition within the same.

Section 3. That the prayer of said petition should be, and the same hereby is, granted, and the village limits of the Village of Hamburg are hereby extended so as to include within said boundaries and in said Village said Truwe's Addition and the whole thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect on its passage, approval and publication and on the filing of a certified copy thereof with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

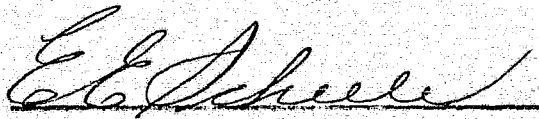
