

ORDINANCE

The Village Council of the Village of Hamburg in the State of Minnesota do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That there has been duly presented to this Village Council a petition signed by all of the owners of land within the following described limits: Commencing at a point 20 rods north of the Southeast corner of Section 29, Township 115, Range 26 in said County of Carver; running thence north along the section line between Sections 28 and 29 of said Town $5\frac{1}{4}$ rods; running thence west parallel with the section line between Sections 29 and 32 of said Town 10 rods; running thence south parallel with the said first mentioned section line $5\frac{1}{4}$ rods; running thence east 10 rods to the place of beginning, being $\frac{32}{100}$ of an acre situate in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 29. And that said petitioner by his said petition asks this Council to have said premises included within the Village of Hamburg and to extend the village boundaries of said village so as to include said premises within the same.

Section 2. That this council deems it expedient and to the best interests of the owner of said premises and to the inhabitants of the Village of Hamburg that the boundaries of said village be extended so as to include said premises within the same.

Section 3. That the prayer of said petition should be, and the same hereby is, granted and the village limits of the Village of Hamburg are hereby extended so as to include within said boundaries and in said village the premises hereinbefore described and the whole thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication and on the filing of a certified copy thereof with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

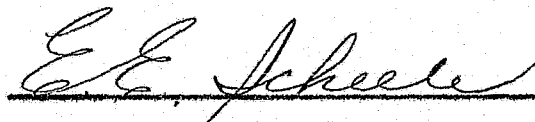
