WHEREAS: Harold Stassen has led a life dedicated to the principles of liberty and peace; and

WHEREAS: Harold Stassen was chosen by President Franklin Delano Roosevelt and then by President Harry S. Truman to serve as an American delegate to the creation of the United Nations organization; and

WHEREAS: The United Nations has served its purpose for over 40 years in preventing a third world war; and

WHEREAS: Harold Stassen is the sole surviving American signer of the United Nations Charter;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 24 to be

HAROLD STASSEN/UNITED NATIONS DAY

In Minnesota.
