WHEREAS: Henry H. Wade was born in Hopkins, Minnesota, on June 13, 1895; and

WHEREAS: he worked for the Minnesota Mines Experimental Station for 47 years as engineer, scientist, chief metallurgist, assistant director, and for 10 years as director; and

WHEREAS: For the first 47 years of the Mines Experimental Station, Mr. Wade contributed a great deal to the development of equipment, the process flow charts, and the commercial plant viability; and

WHEREAS: Henry Wade deserves the recognition from the State of Minnesota for providing the technology that led to the employment of many people on Minnesota's Iron Range;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 18 to be

HENRY H. WADE DAY

in Minnesota.
