



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Higher education week will be observed in the United States for the fifth consecutive year; and

WHEREAS: The purpose of Higher Education week is to call attention to America's colleges and universities in order to provide increased private support and to enhance public awareness about the value of college-educated Americans; and

WHEREAS: The colleges and universities of Minnesota deserve special recognition as invaluable resources for the tools and the foundations of ideas necessary to advance the human condition; and

WHEREAS: These institutions continue to produce educated, responsible citizens whose abilities and talents are utilized by every facet of American government, American business and industry, and private and public organizations of all kinds;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the fourth week of October to be

HIGHER EDUCATION WEEK

in Minnesota and call upon the citizens of Minnesota to take note of this observance and encourage them to actively demonstrate, in some way, their support for higher education in Minnesota.
