



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Members of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries adhere to a strict code of ethics, maintaining the highest standards in their contacts with government, courts, law offices, clients, and all persons; and

WHEREAS: The efficiency of the professional services of legal secretaries is very important to government, the courts, and to attorneys and their clients; and

WHEREAS: One of the aims and purposes of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries is to further the education of its members and to increase their knowledge of the law; and

WHEREAS: It is in the public interest that legal secretaries have the opportunity to observe the government with which they are so closely associated by reason of their profession as legal secretaries;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 12 through October 16, 1967, to be

LEGAL SECRETARIES COURT OBSERVANCE WEEK

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I urge citizens to acknowledge this week appropriately and to recognize and appreciate the safeguards to our liberty, provided by our government of laws and by the orderly process of our courts.
