



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Public Broadcasting Act of 1967, which demonstrated the first comprehensive national commitment to public broadcasting in the United States, was signed on November 7, 1967; and

WHEREAS: The Public Broadcasting Act of 1967 authorized the creation of the Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB) as a private, nonprofit corporation to provide noncommercial radio and television services for the American people; and

WHEREAS: The Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB) has designated November 7, 1967, as Public Broadcasting Day to commemorate the twentieth anniversary of the signing of the Public Broadcasting Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 7 to be

PUBLIC BROADCASTING DAY.
