WHEREAS: More than 2,000 public power systems across the country will join together the week of October 4-10 to celebrate the contributions of community-owned public power; and

WHEREAS: Community-owned public power systems in Minnesota serve over 270,000 customers in 124 communities across the state with efficient, reliable, and cost-effective electricity; and

WHEREAS: The citizens of community-owned public power communities own and control their own electric utility, thereby realizing the security and benefits thereof; and

WHEREAS: Community-owned, public power systems ensure competition and thus, lower rates, throughout the entire electric utility industry within the state and nationwide;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 4 through October 10 to be

PUBLIC POWER WEEK

in Minnesota.
