



Proclamation


- WHEREAS: Physical and mental torture are far too common in this world as a method of punishing political dissension; and
- WHEREAS: The Center for victims of Torture has been operating in Minnesota since 1985 as a nationally-renowned institution for the treatment of victims of politically-motivated torture; and
- WHEREAS: The Center has made an outstanding start in obtaining funding, finding a suitable location, and treating over 70 victims of torture; and
- WHEREAS: Samuel D. Heins has served as president of the Center's board of directors during this critical start-up period; and
- WHEREAS: The Center would not have progressed as it has without the dynamic and effective leadership of Sam Heins; and

SAMUEL D. HEINS DAY


in Minnesota.


