

Proclamation

I, RUDY PERPICH, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY THE CONSTITUTION AND APPLICABLE STATUTES, HEREBY ISSUE THIS PROCLAMATION.

On July 23-24, 1987, severe storms moved across portions of Minnesota, leaving behind WHEREAS:

significant public and individual damage; and

WHEREAS: Resources of local, county and state governments must be fully utilized to ensure

immediate response to prevent worsening conditions; and

WHEREAS: These conditions may require special actions of government and people near the

affected area:

SECRETARY OF STATE

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby declare a State of Emergency to exist within the state of Minnesota and do further direct the agencies of the state to provide such aid as necessary under existing state statutory authority.

This order shall be effective immediately and shall continue until such time that the emergency no longer exists.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fourth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-seven, and of the State the one hundred treathy plath.
