WHEREAS: The Congress of the United States and the Minnesota Legislature passed into law sweeping tax changes; and

WHEREAS: These changes will affect virtually all Minnesota taxpayers in some manner; and

WHEREAS: There is truly a definite need to educate and inform all Minnesotans about these changes; and

WHEREAS: During the week of November 8-14, the Internal Revenue Service and the Minnesota Department of Revenue will cooperatively conduct free tax information sessions at key locations throughout the State of Minnesota, giving Minnesotans a better understanding of these tax changes;
