WHEREAS: The temporary help services industry is a major contributor to a strong U.S. economy; and

WHEREAS: The temporary help services industry employed more than five million people with more than 786,000 jobs daily in 1986; and

WHEREAS: The temporary help services companies provide our area businesses with efficient, qualified people to solve their staff shortages; and

WHEREAS: The temporary help services industry is able to solve these staff shortages so efficiently that, nationally, nine out of every ten companies, ranging in size from small local businesses to multinational companies, utilize temporary help services for their additional staffing needs;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 4 through October 10 to be

TEMPORARY HELP WEEK

in Minnesota.
