WHEREAS: The Minnesota Court System is a separate, independent and equal branch of government; and

WHEREAS: The court system provides a forum for the resolution of disputes by finding facts, interpreting applicable law and ordering its enforcement; and

WHEREAS: The court system is available to all persons, groups and organizations for protection of the personal and property rights provided under the constitution, statutes and common law of the state; and

WHEREAS: The Honorable Miles B. Zimmerman has served as District Court Judge in the Fifth Judicial District since July 1974; and

WHEREAS: Judge Zimmerman's decisions have always been guided by the principles of fairness, impartiality, equal access and timeliness; and

WHEREAS: Judge Zimmerman has always administered justice in an open, consistent, predictable and courteous manner consistent with the highest ideals of public service; and

WHEREAS: All who know Judge Zimmerman respect the high standard he has set for public service, personal sacrifice and personal and judicial integrity;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim December 13 to be
