WHEREAS: The member nations of United Nations Assembly have historically designated December

10th as International Human Rights Day; and

WHEREAS: Human Rights Day is a day of observation of the internationally recognized individual

rights of speech, assembly, expression, and physical integrity; and

WHEREAS: There is currently widespread violation of many human rights in scores of countries

around the world; and

WHEREAS: The need for equal human rights for all persons is a goal of all just societies and

their governments; and

WHEREAS: Minnesotans of all social backgrounds and political persuasions should continue to work

for equal human rights for all;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the tenth day of December to be

HUMAN RIGHTS DAY

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capital this first day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eightyseven, and of the State the one
