WHEREAS: Activity professionals deserve recognition for enhancing the lives of elderly and handicapped persons; and


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the fourth Friday in January to be


### ACTIVITY PROFESSIONAL'S DAY
