WHEREAS: Community colleges are an important educational resource for students of all ages,

backgrounds, and abilities; and

Community colleges provide many essential community services, including career development, counseling, assessment, and developmental education; and WHEREAS:

Through these services, the community colleges meet diverse and changing local needs and perform a vital function within the state's higher education system; and WHEREAS:

In recognition of the important contribution of community colleges to our total educational system, the Congress and President of the United States have designated the month of February as "Community College Month" throughout the United States. WHEREAS:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim February, 1988 to be
