WHEREAS: Cardiovascular diseases and stroke are responsible for more deaths in Minnesota than any other cause, inflicting widespread suffering, and often creating serious economic hardship in our homes and businesses; and

WHEREAS: The American Heart Association, Minnesota Affiliate carries forward a relentless fight against these diseases through its programs of research, public and professional education and community programs, as made possible by private contributions; and

WHEREAS: In recognition of the necessity of constant vigilance against the ravages of cardiovascular disease and to encourage still greater efforts to combat its threat to all Minnesotans;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1988 to be

HEART MONTH

in Minnesota, and call upon citizens to support this important drive with their gifts and voluntary services.
