- WHEREAS: The City of Bloomington is Minnesota's third largest city; and
- WHEREAS: Bloomington has been a leader and an inspiration to communities throughout the metropolitan area and across the state; and
- WHEREAS: The prosperity of Bloomington impacts directly on success of the entire metropolitan area; and
- WHEREAS: James H. Lindau has served the residents of the City of Bloomington with honor and distinction as mayor for eleven years; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Bloomington has advanced economically, socially and spiritually under the competent guidance of Mayor Lindau; and
- WHEREAS: Mayor Lindau has accomplished significant goals while in office, including improvement of Bloomington's image as a place in which to do business, maintenance of fiscal responsibility at the local level, holding the line on property tax increases, spearheading the redevelopment plan for the Metropolitan Stadium site, and generally promoting projects and policies which benefit both Bloomington and the greater Twin Cities area,
