
WHEREAS: December 15 has been designated as Bill of Rights Day, it is therefore appropriate and a pleasant exercise to proclaim the following;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim December 15 to be

MINNESOTA CIVIL LIBERTIES UNION DAY


in Minnesota, in honor of the Minnesota Civil Liberties Union and its efforts in the State of Minnesota since 1952.
