- WHEREAS: As allied health professionals, the opticians of the State of Minnesota are trained to fit and dispense corrective eyewear upon the prescription of an examining doctor; and
- WHEREAS: The proper selection and fitting of eyewear is an integral part of its effectiveness; and
- WHEREAS: Through programs of continuing education, opticians maintain their high levels of competence to assist eyewear consumers in selection of appropriate lenses, frames and regimens of care, and to fit that eyewear so it achieves maximum effectiveness; and
