- WHEREAS: The Continental Basketball Association (CBA) has been in existence for 42 years; and
- WHEREAS: Basketball fans in Rochester and throughout the State of Minnesota wholeheartedly support the CBA and the Rochester Flyers professional team; and
- WHEREAS: The Flyers are the first men's professional basketball team to be based in Minnesota in over seventeen years; and
- WHEREAS: On January 8, 1988, the E.S.P.N. Television Network will carry the Flyer's games to viewers throughout the nation; and
- WHEREAS: The people of Minnesota recognize this opportunity for nationwide coverage for the City of Rochester and the State of Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, January 8, 1988 to be

ROCHESTER FLYERS DAY

in Minnesota, and encourage all citizens to demonstrate support for CBA basketball by filling the Mayo Civic Arena and cheering the Flyers on to victory during their debut on National television.
