WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota has established the Minnesota Amateur Sports Commission; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is dedicated to the promotion of amateur sports; and


WHEREAS: Duluth, Minnesota, was the host city for the 1986 U.S. National Bocce Tournament; and


WHEREAS: Italian, French and Yugoslavian citizens of Minnesota have participated in and played Bocce since the early 1900s; and


WHEREAS: Governor Rudy Perpich has appointed a commission for the sport of Bocce in Minnesota;
