WHEREAS: Catholic Schools in Minnesota have been educating students for well over one hundred years; and

WHEREAS: Catholic Schools are funded by donations and tuition from Catholic parents; and

WHEREAS: Catholic Schools in Minnesota have provided a standard of excellence for these many years, as leaders in academic and Christian education;
