WHEREAS: The information and ideas contained in Minnesota's libraries fuel the energies of Minnesota's economic and intellectual life; and

WHEREAS: Emerging information and communications technologies offer unparalleled opportunities for all Minnesotan to tap these renewable resources; and

WHEREAS: Libraries play an essential role in encouraging a dynamic, literate citizenry; and

WHEREAS: Libraries and library networks work together to remove educational, geographic and economic barriers that limit individuals' access to the state's rich information resources; and

WHEREAS: The board members of the state's public libraries, schools and academic institutions hold these information resources in public trust; and

WHEREAS: Public, school, special and academic librarians add special value to these recorded resources by making them useable and useful;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim February 18, 1988 to be
